Many thanks to the parents and pets (!) who came along to school yesterday to support the JIS Student Council Pet Day. Not all of our students have the opportunity to own or

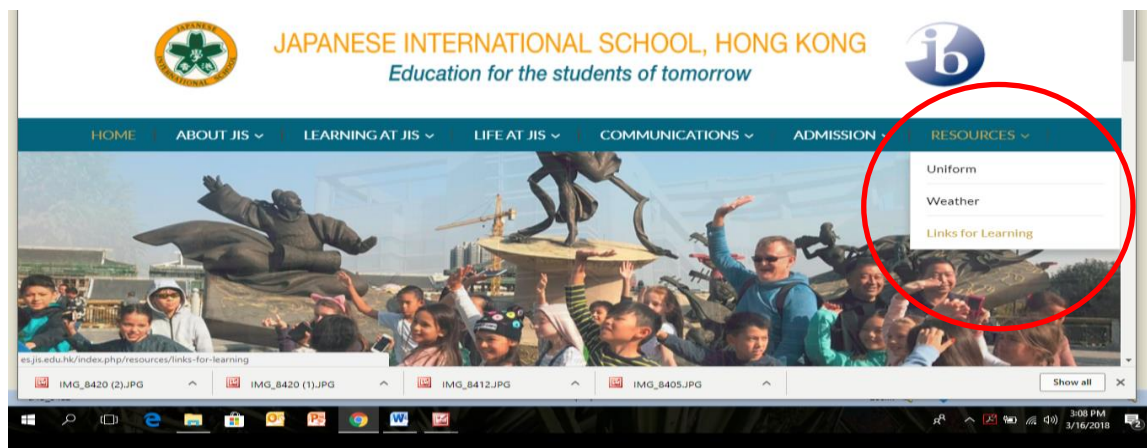
live with animals so it is a great opportunity when they get to learn about, touch and experience family pets.

The animals that came to visit were incredibly patient and calm and some of the owners were asked some rather in-depth questions too!



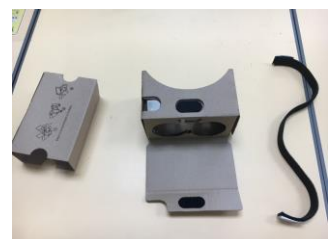
### JIS school website – internet research and other activities, may be of use for the holidays!
