The school is now connected to the community through Class Dojo – look out for message updates, photos and occasional videos about what is going on in your child's classroom. Security and school – important update – please read this carefully



JIS is a very safe environment for children to learn in but we have to make sure we have appropriate security measures to maintain this. Demands on schools to review safety and access increase all the time so we have to be up to date and careful in all our practices. Thank you for your support and understanding so far.

Please remember to park your car appropriately and leave by 3:30 p.m.

All visitors to the school must identify themselves at the school office before they enter the school. Please wear your JIS school i.d. and sign in at the office. (Or receive a visitors badge.) Please make sure all family members and domestic helpers are aware of this and support us.

After school hours when Japanese Section buses have left (around 3:40pm) the rear car park will be closed – the sliding silver gate will be pulled across to prevent people using this exit or entrance. Access in and out of the building will be through the swimming pool entrance doors on the ground floor. Mr Lun (security staff) will have a desk in the entrance area and will sign people in and out of the building. If you have your school I.D. it will be much quicker and safer. All students and visitors to the school after 3:40pm will be asked to use this entrance.

We are keen to keep the school and students safe, be aware of who is in the building and to promote responsible safeguarding practices within our community. Thank you for your support.
