




Food Angel create meals for a variety of groups on a daily basis to ensure that people can have a real meal. They need bags of

## School winter uniform: update

As we enter the cooler weather season we appreciate that students need to wear warmer clothing. The school uniform shop does supply a range of winter clothing (see pic). We ask that all families respect the school uniform and use it for school clothing. If tights or sports clothing leggings are worn they should be black or dark grey – not stripy or bright colours. We do stock long trousers available for both girls and boys and also the tracksuit trousers are warm fleecy fabric. The school 'hoodie' is popular and warm, as well as the terry jacket as an option.

May I also remind students and parents that school shoes should be mainly <u>black</u> in colour. Other sports shoes may be worn on class P.E. days but black shoes at all other times. Thank you for your support.
