



You may remember that last year our school counsellor Ms Yuki Delong ran an Active Parenting Workshop. Those parents who were able to attend reported


that the sessions were most useful.

Effective Discipline

Polite Requests • "I" Messages • Firm Reminders Logical Consequences

Logical Consequence Guidelines

- · Ask child to help choose consequence.
- Use either/or & when/then choices.
- Make sure consequence is logically connected.
- Only give choices you can live with.
- · Keep tone of voice firm and calm.
- · Give choice once, then act.
- Expect testing.
- Allow child to try again later.

- 1 Show up & show support.
- Get to know your child's teachers & encourage them.
- 6 Make learning a family priority.
- Structure homework time.
- Read & talk with your child.
- 6 Filter (& limit) your child's media.

- O Look for alternatives & evaluate consequences.
